### **TPGS Green Energy turns over Singapore's largest trigen plant to Schering-Plough**

Singapore, 10 October 2008 – TPGS Green Energy Pte Ltd (TPGS) today officially turned over the operations of Singapore's largest trigeneration plant to global pharmaceutical company Schering-Plough LTD.

A handover ceremony was held at the premises of Schering-Plough LTD to mark the successful completion of the 10 MW natural gas-fired trigeneration plant, which was developed and built by TPGS under a partnership with Schering-Plough LTD.

During the ceremony, Mr. Lim Kong Puay, Chief Executive Officer of Tuas Power Ltd and Director of TPGS, presented a scale model of the trigeneration plant to Dr. Gaetan Angoh, Managing Director, Schering-Plough LTD, to signify the official handover of the facility. The handover was witnessed by Dr. Patrick Gyselink, Vice President, GSC Asia, Schering-Plough LTD, and Mr. Tan Chin Tung, Chief Executive Officer of Gas Supply Pte Ltd and Director of TPGS.

Groundbreaking for the project began 18 months ago and the trigeneration plant is now fully operational. It is the largest of such facilities in Singapore and is capable of generating 24 tonnes per hour of steam.

With a system efficiency of more than 80%, which is 27% higher than that of conventional plants, the trigeneration plant will help Schering-Plough to cut its fuel consumption by 26% a year and reduce carbon dioxide emissions by 24% annually.

In addition, the plant can be expanded to accommodate an extra 5 MW gas turbine to cater to any increase in demand for steam and electricity in the future.

Under a 15-year agreement with Schering-Plough, TPGS will offer utility provision, maintenance asset management services for the trigeneration facility.

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
